FROM : Chief, Division of Education *J.C.G.*

SUBJECT: Amendment Bradley Contract to include responsibility for entire Educational Program in Iraq.

In respect to USFOTO 252 and USFOTO CIRCERS N8 and NA 11 I submit the following:

1. Have reviewed in detail with Chief of Bradley Mission the Washington Official order to have Bradley University assume total educational program which FOA undertakes with Ministry of Education of Iraq.
2. Chief Bradley Mission requests delay in Bradley University assuming immediate responsibility.
3. Chief Bradley Mission and Chief, Division of Education FOA are working out pattern to shift total responsibility for Education/Iraq program to Bradley University.
4. It is expected that said pattern will be ready to submit to the Iraq Ministry of Education for approval in the immediate future, so that the transition will be completed at the earliest possible date.
5. The present preliminary planning for said adjustment includes:
 - a. Retention of the number of positions now listed in table of organization of present Education Division, FOA for FY 1954 and 1955 all of which will be transferred to Bradley University Mission.
 - b. Elimination of Chief, Division of Education but position retained for competent assistant to Chief, Bradley Mission. This assistant would have charge of program devoted to development of rural education teacher training program.
 - c. Definite proposal to RIF present Chief, Education Division, FOA, the moment new organization pattern is effected which will be not later than, but contemplated to be earlier than July 1, 1954.
 - d. Whatever reprogramming is found necessary in connection with Bradley University assuming full responsibility for educational program in Iraq.

The victim who is engaged in organizing migrant workers in the western part of this country has previously received a threatening communication and investigation is being conducted with regard to this communication.
