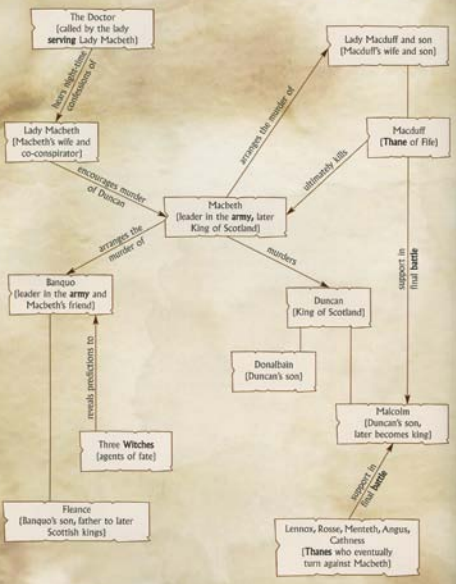
Lady Macbeth, Macbeth's wife
