Explores the symptoms, causes and treatment of this lifelong disease that profoundly affects social functioning, language and behavior.

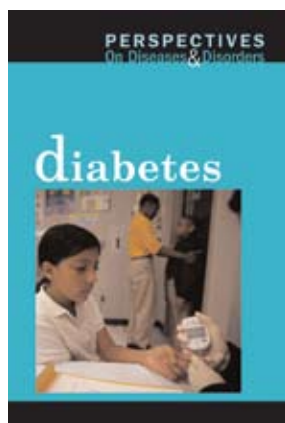

Cancer discusses nearly 100 different types of cancer, including current treatment options and controversial alternatives such as marijuana therapy and the cervical cancer vaccine.

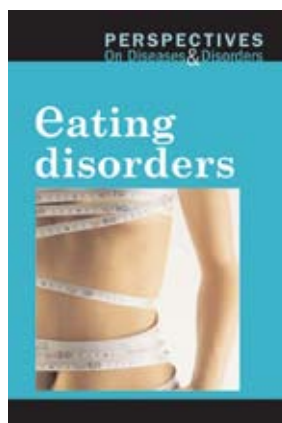
