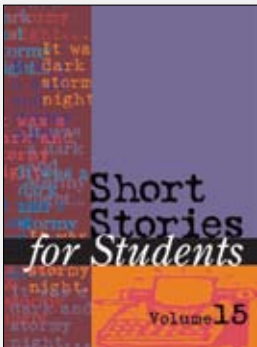
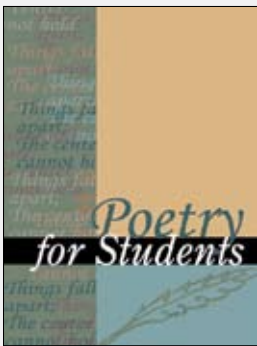
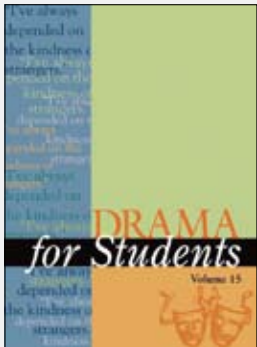
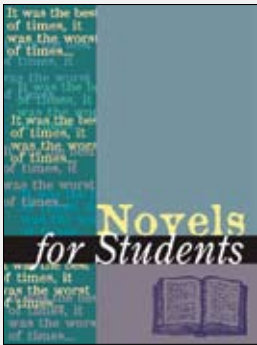
- An introduction featuring an overview of the play or poem

In addition, sidebars highlight media adaptations, related topics for study, lists of related works and more. Additional features include more than 150 illustrations, engravings, paintings and still photographs; a chronology of Shakespeare’s life and career; and a comprehensive subject, theme and character index.
