*After 30 years, a timely reassessment of key authors*

**T**hirty years since its initial publication, the acclaimed *British Writers* Series adds a retrospective supplement of new essays on some of the most important writers featured in the original set. New scholarship has emerged since the original articles were written in the 1970s, and a vastly changed political and social landscape calls for a reassessment of influential writers from a contemporary perspective. *Supplement I* (publishing in 2001) and *Supplement II* (publishing in 2002) present 40 brand new articles on the writers most widely read and studied in high school and college courses, such as James Joyce, T. S. Eliot, Chaucer and many others. In the long-standing tradition of the *Scribner Writers* Series, articles are written by noted scholars who discuss the lives, careers, themes and styles of each writer, placing each in a pertinent historical context for today's readers. Bibliographies aid further research.

If you own *British Writers*, you'll want to maintain the value of the set with these new volumes. If your collection lacks contemporary perspectives on the key writers in the British canon, these are ideal stand-alone volumes.
