# French Biographical



The two microfiche editions of French Biographical Archives I and II (ABF I and II) together with the Supplement contain 425,000 biographical entries from 370 reference works in 727 volumes from the middle of the 17th century right into the 20th century. Biographical encyclopedias and handbooks from all over the world have been used. Together with the Supplement, ABF I and II offer a unique overview of the cultural, economic and social spheres which have influenced the life and history of France and the Frankophone countries.

With the **French Biographical Archive to 1999 (ABF III)** K.G. Saur Verlag has now published a new series of an archive with source works reaching from the 1970s to 1999.

All these sources supplement the information contained in the older reference works and extend the period covered up to the end of the 20th century. However, the **ABF III** amounts to much more than just a supplement: it provides a comprehensive overview of the history of France and the Frankophone countries right up to the present.

About 215 titles with more than 230 volumes which were both useful and important in describing the social, cultural or scientific life, were utilized for

the archive and the approximately 145,000 biographical entries have been arranged in an alphabetical register of names.

In this way the biographies from over 120,000 women and men from a variety of professions and social groups have been collected.

In the **French Biographical Archive to 1999** the special role of education and science in both historical and present day France has been taken into account, as well as the worlds of film, television and radio. For example, the archive includes the biographies of Jean Perrin, Henri Moissan, Charles Richet, Michel Foucault and Emanuelle Béart. Descriptions of the lives of numerous figures from literature, art, music, politics, sport and business complete the picture of contemporary France and the Frankophone countries.

Among the examples of significant women from a vast variety of spheres are Simone Veil, Colette Audry, Giselle Halimi, Jacqueline de Romilly, Martine Aubry, Florence Arthaud and Françoise Arthaud, to mention but a few.

Decentralization during the 1970s and 80s and the related strengthening of regional identities are mirrored in the archive through biographical entries taken from a total of 38 works. The

development of the former French colonies, both before and after their independence, are also illustrated with numerous biographies.

In the **ABF III** great importance has been attached to presenting not only the elites of the state and of society but rather as broad a cross-section of the population as possible.

The **French Biographical Archive to 1999** is a work of universal character, offering research material for the widest variety of topics. It is of considerable benefit to libraries, institutes, colleges, universities and press archives, as were its predecessors ABF I und II before it.

Biographies of 143,100 individuals are included in the **French Biographical Archive (ABF)**. Besides full coverage of France and its various regions the ABF also brings together records on the lives of people from French-speaking Switzerland, Belgium, French Canada and the Francophone colonies. Foreigners who resided in these countries or

were associated with France for some period of their lives are also covered.

Men and women of regional, national and international importance from the worlds of politics, science, commerce, industry and culture are compiled.

The archive covers the period from the very beginnings of French civilization to the turn of the 20th century. The 181 biographical works used, comprising 472 volumes, date from 1647 to 1919.

The second, cumulated and enlarged edition of the French Biographical Index provides biographical data in short form.

To produce the new series and the Supplement of the **French Biographical Archive (ABF II)** biographical material on 180,000 individuals was brought together and 189 biographical reference works published up to the 1990s were compiled.

The 223,100 biographical articles contained in the ABF II and the Supplement not only include additional entries on individuals already listed in the primary work, ABF, but also cover thousands of previously unlisted individuals from the first half of the 20th century.

This archive gives a representative survey of all aspects of French life. As in other archives, users will find here biographies of politicians, artists, scientists, members of the armed forces and many others, all arranged in a single alphabetical sequence.
