Gale Encyclopedia of Multicultural America: Primary Documents

This stand-alone, 2-vol. set offers a wealth of first-hand insights into the experiences of approximately 170 U.S. ethnic groups and perfectly complements the essay approach of the *Gale Encyclopedia of Multicultural America*

Primary Documents includes background on each ethnic group and introductions explaining the context of each document presented. Focusing on written works and oral presentations as well as items representing daily life, the set offers a wide range of full-text and excerpts — both from members of the group themselves or from contemporaries offering a “mainstream” perspective. Look for letters, diary excerpts and oral history transcriptions; speeches; newspaper and magazine articles; songs, poems and works of fiction; household inventories and recipes; treaties and proclamations; political cartoons; and more. Introductory material, full source citations and access by subject and individuals’ names add to the reference value of this much-needed set. Some of the documents included are:

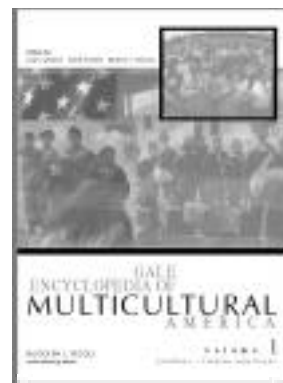
