Notable Black American Scientists

A unique resource presents multicultural achievements in science

For profiles on the achievements, importance and significance of the most noteworthy Black American scientists through time, consult *Notable Black American Scientists*. This new source provides narrative biographical entries on 250 Black American scientists and satisfies the needs of students and general researchers.

Arranged alphabetically, each entry averages two to three pages in length and contains header information providing person's name, birth/death years and major field of endeavor. The rest of the entry focuses on scientific achievements (theories, experiments, research projects, discoveries, inventions, patents, etc.) and provides personal and career information. A personal statement from the scientists about his or her career or the importance of science is included, when possible and appropriate. Entries conclude with a select bibliography of additional sources of information, including works by and about the scientist.

Arranged for easy use with features that keep the interest level high

Additional features include photos, a bibliography of general sources of information on scientists and a science timeline. Definitions of scientific terms that may not be familiar to students or general readers are given in parentheses or explained within the narrative. 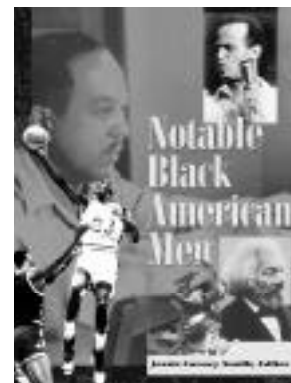
