The Collection

The Sabin Collection from Primary Source Microfilm, an imprint of the Gale Group, is the world's most comprehensive microfiche publication of Americana. This vast collection is based on Joseph Sabin's 28-volume bibliography, started by him in 1800, continued by Wilberforce Eames, and completed by R.W.G. Vail for the Bibliographical Society of America. In this work, Sabin intended to include every written document dealing with the political, governmental, military, economic, social and religious history of the Western Hemisphere, beginning with the discovery of the New World.

Improved Research Access

RLIN MARC is the online "language" of *The Sabin Collection*, dating back to the first film unit (130) released by Primary Source Microfilm. Since that time, a retrospective cataloging project provides records for the earlier collection units (1-129). Now for the first time, Primary Source Microfilm makes all of these US MARC records available to libraries for loading into local or network systems, thereby improving collection documentation and enhancing multi-user access in the online environment.

By special contract with MARCLink (Provo, Utah, USA), Primary Source Microfilm offers these records directly to libraries in either RLIN or OCLC US MARC format, with delivery by FTP, nine-track tape or other means. Special customization needs for libraries and their systems are handled through this working arrangement.

A sample record file is available for viewing or test downloading through MARCLink's FTP site (<ftp://ftp.marclink.com/PSM/>). The first release (1999) includes the 9,962 titles in units 1-117; the second release (2000) covers the more than 10,000 titles in units 118-219. Periodic updates will be issued on a scheduled basis to follow the release of ongoing film units.

The RLIN MARC Records

The Sabin Collection is cataloged at full level, both for the older (Lost Cause Press) and the more recent units, with the main difference being that the cataloging for the latter is based on strict physical inspection of the item. Each record carries a 533 microform reproduction note and an 830 uniform series title statement for the collection. The *Sabin* bibliography number and *The Sabin Collection* group or unit number are also included in each record. Beginning with unit 130, the assigned subject category and sequential title number are added to each record. Unit 179 marks the introduction of uniform 035 local field notes for the collection unit number, the assigned subject category and sequential title number.
