
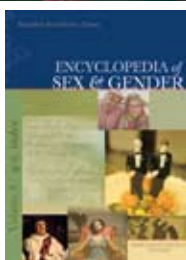

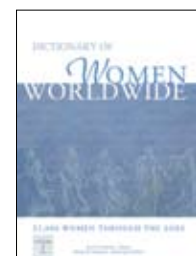

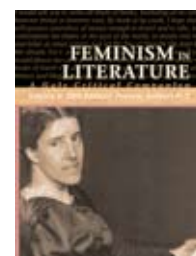


Feminism in Literature

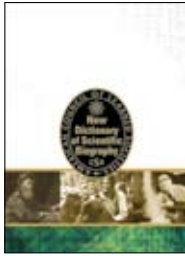
